

Chart 1.1 Number of HIV/AIDS reported





Chart 2.1 Gender distribution of reported HIV by quarter




**Chart 2.2 Gender distribution of reported HIV by year**





**Chart 2.4 Gender distribution of reported AIDS by year**




**Chart 3.1 Distribution of ethnicity of reported HIV**

**Chart 3.2 Distribution of ethnicity of reported AIDS**





**Chart 4.1 Age distribution of reported HIV**




**Chart 4.2 Age group & gender of total reported HIV**





**Chart 4.4 Age group & gender of total reported AIDS**




Chart 5.1 Exposure categories of reported HIV




**Chart 8.1 Source of referral of reported HIV**

**Chart 8.2 Source of referral of Reported AIDS**








